ENGLISH CENTER

The English Center is an intensive immersion program open to anyone who would like to learn and improve their English language skills. The program's primary mission is to help students develop their academic English language skills in order to meet the university's English proficiency requirements, so that they can successfully enrol in an AIIAS graduate program. The English Center also offers classes to students intending to only study English and enhance their language skills, and their ability to communicate fluently and effectively in English.

The AIIAS English Center has four levels of English from beginner to advanced. Students are placed in a level based on their proficiency in English at entry. Each level focuses on developing reading, writing, speaking, listening and grammar skills. The program is intensive, so the students learn English as quickly as possible. Students have 15 hours of class per week and 8 additional hours of supervised laboratory work, as well as homework.

Additionally, for students who plan to move into a degree program, AIIAS offers a transition program for those who are close to the minimum required English language proficiency score, but still need to improve their English. These students typically take graduate classes half time and English half time.

CLASS SCHEDULES

Classes begin five times a year in

- January
- March
- June
- August
- October

Terms are 8 weeks long.

AIIAS is located in the Philippines, only about an hour from Manila and its international airport.
