ENGLISH CENTER

The English Center is an intensive immersion program open to anyone who wants to learn and improve their English language skills. The program's primary mission is to help students develop their academic English language skills to meet the institute's English proficiency requirements to enroll in an AIAS graduate program successfully. The English Center also offers classes to students intending only to study English and enhance language skills and their ability to communicate fluently and effectively in English.

The AIAS English Center has four levels of English, from beginner to advanced. Students are placed in a level based on their proficiency in English at entry. Each level focuses on developing reading, writing, speaking, listening, and grammar skills. The program's design enables students to achieve proficiency in English in a shorter amount of time. Students have 15 hours of class per week, eight additional hours of supervised laboratory work, and homework.

Additionally, for students who plan to move into a degree program, AIAS offers a transition program for those close to the minimum required English language proficiency score but still need to improve their English. These students typically take graduate classes half-time and English half-time.

CLASS SCHEDULES

Classes begin five times a year in

- January
- March
- June
- August
- October

Terms are eight weeks long.
