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

Master of Arts in Ministry (MA-Min) — a missiological degree for ministry in cross-cultural settings

The MA-Min is a missiological degree that trains church pastors, leaders, and administrators to serve more effectively in cross-cultural settings, specifically in the 10/40 Window. This degree also prepares students for the DMiss degree.

Doctor of Ministry (DMin) — an advanced professional degree for administrators and church leaders
