Responsibility Overview:

Faculty members are also expected to contribute to their area of specialization at professional conferences and through the publication of books and articles as well as to the wider church community.

Faculty teaching doctoral level are required to hold a doctoral degree, and faculty teaching master level are required to hold at least a Master's degree. The faculty member is expected to fully meet the role requirements for his/ her academic rank in the areas of teaching, scholarship, and service. The teaching role includes maintaining a high level of excellence in each aspect of the academic endeavor, as these contribute to meeting the goals and working towards fulfillment of the institutional mission. The faculty member forms a close relationship with students in the department and is sensitive to their needs. The faculty member is a reliable guide for students and a mentor in professional growth.

Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- 1. Teach graduate-level Accounting and Finance courses, including online and at extension learning centers.
- 2. Serve as academic adviser and mentor for masteral and doctoral students.
- 3. Supervise theses and dissertations.
- 4. Engage in academic research and publish in peer-reviewed outlets.
- 5. Participate in institutional service, outreach, and professional development.
- 6. Other duties as assigned by the Dean or Vice President for Academic Affairs.
